- ✓ Are you a young person with a learning disability who is keen to develop new skills in the workplace?
- ✓ Are you ready to work together to achieve paid employment?
- ✓ Are you working at entry level 2 for both Functional English and Maths?
- ✓ You need to know what work involves and be committed to staying on the course once you begin, and then aim to gain employment when you finish.
- ✓ You need to have a supportive family who is going to work with Mission EmployAble to assist you in gaining employment and encouraging your independence.
- ✓ Mission EmployAble's training centre is Café on The Common, Rickmansworth Road, Chorleywood, Herts WD3 5SG.
